## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 10-1-393 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 unfair or deceptive practices in consumer transactions, so as to add as an example of unfair 3 or deceptive acts or practices the making of false or misleading statements regarding the 4 limited supply of or the duration of discounted purchase prices for consumer goods; to 5 provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for 6 other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8	SECTION 1.
9	Code Section 10-1-393 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to unfair or
10	deceptive practices in consumer transactions, is amended by adding a new paragraph to
11	subsection (b) to read as follows:
12	"(11.1)(A) Making false or misleading statements concerning the limited supply or
13	scarcity of a consumer good or the limited duration of a discounted purchase price for
14	<u>a consumer good.</u>
15	(B) For purposes of this paragraph, the term 'consumer good' means any good that is
16	used or bought by consumers primarily for personal, family, or household purposes;"
