A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 3 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 administrative personnel of the General Assembly, so as to provide that all official
- 3 communications to officers, members, or employees of the General Assembly be provided
- 4 in an electronic format; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 3 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to administrative
- 9 personnel of the General Assembly, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 "<u>28-3-24.2.</u>
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'official written communication' means any
- 13 report, notice, or other written correspondence required by the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated, as now or hereafter amended, or by any other state regulation or directive, to
- be provided to officers, members, or employees of the General Assembly.
- 16 (b) It is the policy of the General Assembly that whenever an official written
- 17 communication is sent to officers, members, or employees of the General Assembly such
- communication shall be in an electronic format that creates a record that may be retained,
- 19 retrieved, and reviewed by a recipient thereof and that may be directly reproduced in paper
- 20 <u>form by such a recipient."</u>
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
