- 1 Recognizing and commending the Bicentennial Celebration in Swainsboro, Georgia; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, this year, Swainsboro, Georgia, is celebrating the 200th anniversary of its
- 4 creation; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Swainsboro is planning a season of Bicentennial Celebration from December
- 6 2022 to May 2023; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in 1822, a legislative Act was introduced by Allen Daniel, Speaker of the House
- 8 of Representatives, and Matthew Talbot, President of the Senate, and signed into legislation
- 9 by Governor John Clark to incorporate the City of Swainsboro; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Swainsboro is unique in that there is only one Swainsboro in the world; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Swainsboro is known as the "Crossroads of the Great South" for the crossroads
- of two of the most historically relevant cross-country routes in America, US Route 80 and
