A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Bicentennial Celebration in Swainsboro, Georgia; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, this year, Swainsboro, Georgia, is celebrating the 200th anniversary of its
4 creation; and

5 WHEREAS, Swainsboro is planning a season of Bicentennial Celebration from December
6 2022 to May 2023; and

7 WHEREAS, in 1822, a legislative Act was introduced by Allen Daniel, Speaker of the House
8 of Representatives, and Matthew Talbot, President of the Senate, and signed into legislation
9 by Governor John Clark to incorporate the City of Swainsboro; and

10 WHEREAS, Swainsboro is unique in that there is only one Swainsboro in the world; and

11 WHEREAS, Swainsboro is known as the "Crossroads of the Great South" for the crossroads
12 of two of the most historically relevant cross-country routes in America, US Route 80 and
13 US Route 1, which cross in the heart of downtown Swainsboro; and

14 WHEREAS, Swainsboro is a city of excellence due to its architecture, commerce, and
15 community planning and development.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize and commend the Bicentennial Celebration in Swainsboro, Georgia.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
19 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
20 press.
