4 vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare
5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

8 dramatically by her superlative service with various hospitals and medical facilities

21 church; and as a supporter of various civic and civil rights organizations; and

22 WHEREAS, her vision and unyielding commitment to the freedom, safety, and overall
23 well-being of the citizens of Georgia have set the standard for civic service; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
