## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Charlie Flemming on his outstanding service; and for other

5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
23 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
25 recognize and commend Charlie Flemming for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and  
26 dedicated service to the American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial
