A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the Northwest Georgia Logistics Corridor as an official logistics growth corridor
- 2 in Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Georgia's economy would greatly benefit from additional well-designed
- 4 logistics capacity; and
- 5 WHEREAS, it is highly desirable to review current state incentives, as well as opportunities
- 6 for future incentives for logistics and intermodal capacity growth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to establish specific logistics, transportation growth
- 8 corridors, and integrated clusters of support activities in this state, and such corridors would
- 9 directly foster the effective growth of capacity in intrastate and interstate freight movement,
- 10 distribution center operations, and logistics workforce participants through local
- 11 collaboration among higher education entities, private sector logistics companies, and
- 12 governmental bodies; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it would be advantageous for official corridors to be established for the pursuit
- 14 of state and federal grant funds.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL

- 16 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the Northwest Georgia Logistics Corridor shall be
- 17 composed of communities in all of Carroll, Chattooga, Douglas, Floyd, Haralson, Heard,
- 18 Paulding, Polk, and Walker Counties.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ENACTED that the members of this body designate
- 20 the Northwest Georgia Logistics Corridor as an official logistics growth corridor in the State
- 21 of Georgia.
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 23 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
- 24 press.
