- 2 law enforcement, the military branches of the United States, or as firefighters and
- 3 recognizing May 2023 as United in Uniforms Recognition and Memorial Month; and for

- 5 WHEREAS, men and women from the State of Georgia have taken the oath and pledge to
- 6 heed the call of those in danger at any time, serve and protect the citizens and properties of
- 7 Georgia, defend our freedoms against enemies both foreign and domestic, and be willing to

- 9 WHEREAS, the month of May currently includes International Firefighters Day, Police
- 10 Week, and Memorial Day weekend, all of which honor our uniformed heros for their service
- and sacrifices within our state and nation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, from the time of the creation of the first department in 1736, the first police
- department in 1844, and the first military branch in America in 1784, men and women have
- raised their hands, swore allegiance, endured rigorous training, and given their lives for other
