## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing and commending Devereux Advanced Behavioral Health Georgia for 50 years
 of dedicated and outstanding service; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Devereux Advanced Behavioral Health, founded in 1912 by special education
pioneer Helena Devereux, operates a comprehensive national network of clinical,
therapeutic, educational, and employment programs and services that positively impact the
lives of tens of thousands of children, adults, and their families every year; and

WHEREAS, Devereux is now one of the nation's largest nonprofit organizations providing
services, insight, and leadership in the evolving field of behavioral healthcare and serving
many of our country's most vulnerable populations in the areas of autism, intellectual and
developmental disabilities, specialty mental health, education, and foster care; and

WHEREAS, Devereux Georgia was established in Cobb County in 1973 at the request ofthen-Governor Jimmy Carter's administration; and

WHEREAS, since that time, Devereux Georgia has offered hope and healing to children and
adolescents and their families who are living with emotional, behavioral, and cognitive
differences; and

16 WHEREAS, Devereux Georgia employees work tirelessly to provide the highest quality and 17 most compassionate care and support for youth impacted by behavioral health concerns via 18 a comprehensive continuum of care of programs including: comprehensive assessments, 19 diagnostics, and measurements to support data-driven care; evidence-based treatment and 20 special education; transition and independent life services; family education and professional 21 training; research and innovation to advance the field; and advocacy, public awareness, and 22 prevention; and

23 WHEREAS, Devereux Georgia is accredited by The Joint Commission, which sets it apart 24 and indicates the highest standard in healthcare, and is licensed by the state with clinicians 25 who offer expertise in evidenced-based trauma-informed treatment reflective of adolescent brain development, including trauma-focused cognitive behavioral therapy, dialectical 26 27 behavior therapy, neurofeedback, behavior analysis, and Devereux positive behavior 28 intervention and supports.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body 30 extend their deepest appreciation and respect to Devereux Advanced Behavioral Health 31 Georgia as well as its staff, advisory board members, and volunteers, and convey to them this 32 legislative body's most sincere commendation for its 50 years of service in Georgia.
