A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Forsyth County Board of Commissioners Chairwoman Laura
2 Semanson; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Chairwoman Semanson made history by becoming the first woman to chair the
4 Forsyth County Board of Commissioners since the board was first convened; and

5 WHEREAS, Chairwoman Semanson was elected in 2016 to serve the 2017–2020 term
6 representing Forsyth County District 5, which encompasses an eastern sweep of the county,
7 including the Lake Lanier region; and

8 WHEREAS, she was elected by the board of commissioners to serve as secretary for 2017,
9 and serves on the Water and Sewer Committee, the Finance Committee, and the Lanier Joint
10 Development Authority; and

11 WHEREAS, since relocating to Forsyth County in 2001, she has been active in the
12 community, volunteering for various citizens' organizations, coaching youth running, and
13 serving as an officer for her homeowners' association; and

14 WHEREAS, Chairwoman Semanson has been dedicated to providing the highest standard
15 of public service to her constituents, and she remains steadfastly committed to the principles
16 of efficiency, integrity, and responsibility; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
18 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 recognize and commend Forsyth County Board of Commissioners Chairwoman Laura
21 Semanson for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of
22 Georgia, and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued success.
