A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending David Andrews; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, David Andrews is a Georgia native who grew up in Johns Creek, Georgia,
- 3 where he played high school football at Wesleyan; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he graduated from Wesleyan in 2010 as a three-star prospect named in the top
- 5 ten prospects for centers nationally, and was recruited by the University of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he joined the NFL as a free agent in 2015, was signed onto the New England
- 7 Patriots in May of that year, started ten out of 16 games, and was runner-up for the 2016 Pro
- 8 Bowl, based on fan votes; and
- 9 WHEREAS, David played in the indispensable position of center and contributed to the
- 10 team's overall success through his unyielding perseverance, his keen sensitivity to the
- developments of each play, and his unconditional support of every other member of the team;

- 13 WHEREAS, during his distinguished career at the University of Georgia, David received
- 14 numerous awards that recognized his leadership and contributions to the team, such as the
- 15 2012 Leon Farmer Award, the 2012 and 2013 Coach's Leadership Award, and the 2014
- 16 Vince Dooley Award, an award that goes to the most valuable player of the season; and
- 17 WHEREAS, David was named team captain four times during the 2013 season and faithfully
- 18 served as a permanent captain for the 2014 season; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in 2014, he set a team-best 39 consecutive games started and was one of six
- 20 finalists for the 2014 Rimington Trophy; and

21 WHEREAS, in 2016, despite joining the NFL as an undrafted rookie free agent in 2015,

- 22 David became the New England Patriots starting center, playing all 16 regular season games
- 23 and eventually starting in Super Bowl LI, where he earned his first of two Super Bowl wins;

- 25 WHEREAS, David returned to his home state in 2018 to help his team win Super Bowl LII
- against the St. Louis Rams, and was named cocaptain for the second year in a row; and
- 27 WHEREAS, as this player has earned recognition by performing with vigor and precision
- 28 over years of training and competition, it is fitting and proper to commend such an
- 29 outstanding Georgia athlete.
- 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 31 recognize and commend David Andrews on his extraordinary accomplishment as a
- 32 student-athlete with the University of Georgia football team, two-time Super Bowl winner,
- and for his public service to the citizens of Georgia.
