- 2 and culture; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Amir is the beloved son of the late Claude Lee, Jr., and Evelyn M. Lee and a
- 4 native of Savannah and Hilton Head Island; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he is a cum laude graduate of Savannah State University with dual degrees, and
- 6 he earned his Juris Doctorate from the Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University
- 7 in Macon, Georgia; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Amir is often called the "People's Historian"; he is the resident scholar for
- 9 Geechee Kunda Cultural Center and Museum in Riceboro, Georgia, and is known as a Djeli,
- 10 a cultural historian, who shares the history of African people at home and in the diaspora;

- 12 WHEREAS, Amir is the founder of Day Clean: The African Soul and Day Clean Journeys,
- and he puts emphasis on African history, culture, and empowerment; and

- 15 has performed in front of the Prime Minister of Haiti, the Liberian Ambassador to the United
- 16 States, the Mayor of Savannah, Danny Glover, and the director of the Gambian National

- 18 WHEREAS, Amir has written the Black History Month Moments for local NBC affiliates
- 19 since 2010 and has provided information on African history and culture for the BBC,
- 20 national and international print media, and local television networks; and

- 23 currently a professor at Savannah State University in the Africana Studies Program; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Amir has received numerous awards for his work, including the 2004 William
- 25 K. Broker Citizen Award, the 2009 Spirit of Excellence Entrepreneur of the Year, the 2015
- 26 Chatham County Juneteenth Award, 2015 Kuumba Honoree, and 2016 City of Savannah
- 27 Black Heritage Festival Honoree.
