- 1 Recognizing Mr. Wayne Mason and dedicating a road in his honor; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Wayne Mason has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the
- 3 vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare
- 4 of the citizens of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a native of Gwinnett County, Mr. Mason is the founder and president of Mason
- 6 Family Companies, which invests and develops single-family and multifamily properties and
- 7 commercial and industrial developments throughout metropolitan Atlanta and the Southeast;

- 9 WHEREAS, just a few of Mr. Mason's accomplishments with Mason Family Companies
- 10 include developing the 300 acre Cisco Systems corporate campus; Gwinnett County's first
- 11 mixed use project, Global Forum; Duluth's first mixed use project, Crossroads; 400
- 12 Commons in Forsyth County; assembling property for Discover Mills in Lawrenceville; and
- 13 planning of redevelopment which helped spur the City of Atlanta's Beltline; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Mason served on the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners from 1972
- 15 to 1980, where his tenure was marked with numerous accomplishments, including
- 16 developing lasting relationships with bond and finance houses which led to county
- 17 infrastructure improvements such as a new water treatment plant, more than 800 miles of
- 18 roads, a county-wide fire protection network, Gwinnett's first modern police headquarters,
- 19 the county's first land use plan, and the county's first business licensing program; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
- 21 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
- dramatically by his superlative service on behalf of Gwinnett County, serving as a board

- 33 Gwinnett County is dedicated as the Wayne Mason Highway.
- 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
- 35 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Wayne Mason Highway.
