A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending United States Senator John Isakson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Senator John Isakson has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for
- 3 the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the
- 4 welfare of the citizens of Georgia and the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, John Hardy Isakson was born on December 28, 1944, in Atlanta, Georgia, and
- 6 served in the Georgia Air National Guard for six years, where he attained the rank of staff
- 7 sergeant; and
- 8 WHEREAS, after graduating from the University of Georgia, he embarked on a career in real
- 9 estate with Northside Realty, a company his father helped to establish; he became president
- of the company in 1979, a position he held for 22 years, during which time it became the
- 11 biggest independent real estate company in the Southeast and one of the largest in the
- 12 country; and
- WHEREAS, in 1976, Senator Isakson was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives
- 14 where he served seven terms, four of them as the Republican Minority Leader, and went on
- 15 to serve in the Georgia Senate for one term; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he won his seat in the United States House of Representatives in a 1999 special
- 17 election and was re-elected to two more terms; he served on the House Education Committee
- and was instrumental in the passage of the No Child Left Behind Act; and
- 19 WHEREAS, this dedicated public servant was first elected to the United States Senate in
- 20 2004, a historic occasion as it marked the first time in Georgia's history that both U.S. Senate
- 21 seats had been held by Republicans; and

22 WHEREAS, Senator Isakson was twice more elected to the United States Senate and served

- 23 honorably until his resignation in 2019, sponsoring over 130 bills and assuming leadership
- 24 roles on issues involving veterans affairs and international trade; and
- 25 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman has given inspiration to many through his high
- 26 ideals, morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens, and he has earned a well-deserved
- 27 reputation as one of the nation's finest statesmen; and
- 28 WHEREAS, a resident of Marietta, Georgia, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with
- an unimpeachable reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Senator Isakson has served this state and nation with honor and distinction, and
- 31 his vision and unyielding commitment have set the standard for public service; and
- 32 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 33 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 35 recognize and commend Senator John Isakson for his inspiring and passionate leadership and
- 36 his efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of Georgia and the
- 37 United States.
