A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing October 2024 as Hindu Heritage Month; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Hinduism is one of the world's largest and oldest religions with more than 1.3
billion adherents in over 100 countries, encompassing an array of diverse traditions and
belief systems with values of acceptance, mutual respect, and peace; and

5 WHEREAS, the United States has been a beacon of hope, progress, and innovation, 6 welcoming more than 4 million Hindus from all corners of the world and providing them 7 with better opportunities and the freedom to practice Hinduism; and

8 WHEREAS, Hindu Americans represent one of the world's oldest civilizations and one of
9 the fastest-growing communities in the country as well as in Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Hindus strive to achieve dharma, a code of conduct for living that emphasizes
ethics, morality, righteousness, duty, responsibility, law and order, service to humanity,
nature, environment, ecology, and inclusivity; and

WHEREAS, Hindu heritage, culture, traditions, and values, including Yoga and Ayurveda,
can provide solutions to many of life's challenges and often serve as a source of inspiration,

WHEREAS, the practice of Hinduism seeks to promote unity among all communities,increase awareness of the heritage's values, and educate society on issues affecting the Hindu

discourse, and debate, Hindu Americans have made significant contributions to all aspects
of our society—from science and medicine to business, politics, and industry—all while

WHEREAS, during the month of October, the culture, history, traditions, achievements, and
contributions of Hindu Americans are recognized and celebrated throughout the United
States and in Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the State of Georgia embraces the diversity represented in our communities and
seeks to afford all residents the opportunity to better understand, recognize, and appreciate
the rich history and shared experiences of Hindu Americans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
recognize October 2024 as Hindu Heritage Month.
