WHEREAS, in 1984, he was hired as the first state coordinator for what later became theGeorgia Environmental Facilities Finance Authority; and

WHEREAS, in 1987, he began working at the Association County Commissioners ofGeorgia, serving as the association's policy director and deputy director; and

WHEREAS, he was appointed as executive director of at the Association CountyCommissioners of Georgia in May 2010; and

WHEREAS, he worked diligently and conscientiously on behalf of Georgia's county officials
and their communities, with a focus on public policy and advocacy, leadership development,
civic and community engagement, and cost-efficient programs such as insurance and
retirement; and

WHEREAS, he retired in 2017 after 30 years of efficient and dedicated public service withthe Association County Commissioners of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable patience and diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this state earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of thisremarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
