A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Georgia so as to provide that the
- 2 General Assembly may provide for the allocation of certain funds to, the creation of a
- 3 continuing fund for, the dedication of specific revenues to, and a program of public funding
- 4 for campaigns for membership in the General Assembly; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 correct a numbering issue; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification
- 6 or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article III, Section VI of the Constitution is amended by revising Paragraph VI by
- 10 redesignating the second paragraph (g) as paragraph (h) and by adding a new paragraph to
- 11 read as follows:

- 12 "(i) The General Assembly is authorized to provide by general law a program of public
- funding for campaigns for membership in the General Assembly and to designate the
- 14 qualifications and limitations on such funding. The General Assembly is authorized to
- allocate funds for such program of public funding, to create a continuing fund for such
- program, and to dedicate revenues to such fund for such program."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 19 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 20 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 21 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that the
- 22 () NO General Assembly may provide by general law for a program of public
- funding for campaigns for membership in the General Assembly and to
- provide a continuing fund for such program and the dedication of certain
- revenues to such fund?"

26 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."

- 27 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 29 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
