STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DE-PARTMENT OF INSURANCE RELATING TO ADOPTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the Department of Insurance relating to Adoption of the International Fire Code are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 18.01.50, Department of Insurance, Adoption of the International Fire Code, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 18-0150-1601, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
