SENATE BILL NO. 1104, As Amended

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTION 33-1204, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT  
2 THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY REQUIRE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AS A  
3 CONDITION OF CERTIFICATE RENEWAL, TO PROVIDE AN OPTION FOR COMPLETING  
4 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CREDITS, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 33-1204, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
8 amended to read as follows:

9 33-1204. VALIDITY, DURATION, RENEWAL, AND LAPSE OF CERTIFICATES. (1)  
10 The state board of education shall by rule provide for the validity, dura-  
11 tion, renewal, and lapse of certificates. In addition, rules promulgated by  
12 the state board of education shall set forth criteria for renewal of admin-  
13 istrator certificates, which shall include a requirement that administrator  
14 certificate holders must complete a course consisting of a minimum of three  
15 (3) semester credits in the statewide framework for teachers' evaluations,  
16 such course shall include a laboratory component.

17 (2) If the holder of a certificate who has undergone a criminal history  
18 check pursuant to district policy as provided in ~~subsection (15) of section~~  
19 33-512(15), Idaho Code, is found to have been convicted of any felony crime  
20 enumerated in section 33-1208, Idaho Code, the certificate shall be revoked  
21 or suspended as provided in this chapter.

22 (3) The state board of education may by rule require professional de-  
23 velopment credits as a condition of certificate renewal, provided that such  
24 rule must recognize providing instruction in a professional development  
25 course or in a course at an institution of higher education as an option to  
26 complete required credits.
