A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE STATE
3 BOARD OF AND STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING
4 UNIFORMITY.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
11 State Board of and State Department of Education relating to Rules Govern-
12 ing Uniformity are not consistent with legislative intent and should be re-
13 jected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular
15 Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House
16 of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 08.02.02, State Board
17 of and State Department of Education, Rules Governing Uniformity, adopted
18 as a pending rule under Docket Number 08-0202-1605, the entire rulemaking
19 docket, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no
20 force and effect.
