A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$700,000, or as much of that amount
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the State Board of Education for the purpose of
7 providing a grant to the Simon Wiesenthal Center's Midwest
8 Region office in Chicago to establish 2 mobile tolerance
9 education centers.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
11 2019.
