SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates various amounts to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for its ordinary and contingent expenses. Appropriates the amount of \$164,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for public defender training. Appropriates the amount of \$585,600 from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile Defender Resource Center. Effective July 1, 2024.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those
5	amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
6	purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7	to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of
8	the State Appellate Defender:
9	For Personal Services\$26,250,200
10	For State Contributions to Social Security\$2,008,086
11	For Contractual Services\$19,359,014
12	For Travel\$47,000
13	For Commodities\$38,000
14	For Printing\$20,000
15	For Equipment\$115,000
16	For EDP\$1,829,560
17	For Telecommunications\$43,000
18	Section 10. The amount of \$231,300, or so much thereof as
19	may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
20	to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary
21	and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

- 1 Section 15. The amount of \$164,000, or so much thereof as
- 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 3 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide
- 4 statewide training to public defenders under the Public
- 5 Defender Training Program.
- 6 Section 20. The amount of \$585,600, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 8 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a
- 9 Juvenile Defender Resource Center.
- 10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
