## HOUSE BILL No. 1016

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 3-8-1-34, AS AMENDED BY P.L.233-2015, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2025]: Sec. 34. (a) A candidate for a school board office must have resided in the school corporation for at least one (1) year before the election.
(b) This subsection applies to a candidate for a school board office seeking to represent an election district that consists of less than the entire school corporation. The candidate must have resided in the election district for at least one (1) year before the election.
(c) A candidate for a school board office may not be an employee or agent of that school corporation.
