DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 24-4-23; IC 35-52-24-20.5.

Synopsis: Shared mobility devices. Requires the vendor of a shared mobility device to: (1) assume liability for damages incurred in connection with the shared mobility device; (2) maintain liability insurance to cover damages; (3) make available to the public a toll free telephone number to reach the vendor; and (4) respond to contacts within 24 hours. Makes a violation of these provisions a class A misdemeanor.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

HOUSE BILL No. 1036

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning trade regulation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 24-4-23 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
1, 2019]:
Chapter 23. Shared Mobility Devices
Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "shared mobility device" means
a device that:
(1) has at least two (2) wheels in contact with the ground with
a floorboard for the user to stand on when using the device;
and
(2) is propelled by a motor at not more than twenty (20) miles
per hour.
Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "vendor" means a person that
makes available to the public for consideration a shared mobility
device.
Sec. 3. A vendor shall do all of the following:
(1) Assume liability for the total cost of property damage or
bodily injury suffered by a person in connection with the use

2	(2) Maintain liability insurance to cover any loss incurred by
