## **HOUSE BILL No. 1060**

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 22-13-2-3.6; IC 36-7.

**Synopsis:** Regulation of building materials. Provides that a state agency or political subdivision may not adopt or enforce a law in certain instances as it relates to building products, materials, and aesthetic methods for Class 1 and Class 2 structures.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1060**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

2	(b) As used in this section, "national code" refers to a national
3	code that:

6	(2) has been published within the last three (3) code
7	publications.
8	(c) Notwithstanding any other law or provision and except as
9	provided in subsection (f), a state agency or political subdivision
10	may not adopt or enforce a law that:
11	(1) prohibits; or
12	(2) limits;
13	the use or installation of a building product, a material, or an
14	aesthetic method in the construction or maintenance of a Class 1
15	or Class 2 structure if the building product or material is approved
16	for use by a national code.
17	(d) Notwithstanding any other law or provision and except as
18	provided in subsection (f), a state agency or political subdivision
19	may not adopt or enforce a law that establishes a construction or
20	maintenance standard for:
21	(1) a building product;
22	(2) a material; or
23	(3) an aesthetic method;
24	for a Class 1 or Class 2 structure that includes more stringent or
25	detailed requirements that conflict with a standard published in a
26	national code.
27	(e) A state agency or political subdivision that adopts a building
28	law governing the construction or maintenance of a Class 1 or
29	Class 2 structure may amend a provision of the building law to
30	address local conditions only if the amendment does not conflict
31	with subsection (b).
32	(f) A political subdivision may adopt or enforce a law described
33	in subsection (c) or (d) that applies to a structure located in a
34	historic, a historical, or an architectural district designated after
35	June 30, 2020, by the political subdivision, if the political
36	subdivision has consent from the owner of the structure.
37	(g) A person aggrieved by an action in violation of this chapter
38	may file a petition in circuit or superior court to obtain an
39	injunction against a violation of this chapter by a state agency or
40	political subdivision.
41	(h) A regulation, rule, or ordinance that conflicts with this
