HOUSE BILL No. 1145

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 33-33-26-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 1. (a) Gibson County
3	constitutes the sixty-sixth judicial circuit.
4	(b) The judge of the Gibson superior court may appoint one (1)
5	full-time magistrate under IC 33-23-5 to serve the superior court.
6	(c) The magistrate continues in office until removed by the
7	judge of the Gibson superior court.
