

HOUSE BILL No. 1145

DIGEST OF HB 1145 (Updated January 21, 2020 6:01 pm - DI 113)

Citations Affected: IC 33-33.

Synopsis: Gibson and Hamilton County courts. Allows the judges of the Gibson superior court and Gibson circuit court to appoint a magistrate. Allows the appointed magistrate for Gibson County to serve both the Gibson superior court and the Gibson circuit court. Allows the judges of the Hamilton circuit and superior courts to jointly appoint an additional magistrate to serve the Hamilton County courts.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

HOUSE BILL No. 1145

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 33-33-26-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 1. (a) Gibson County
constitutes the sixty-sixth judicial circuit.

- (b) The judges of the Gibson superior court and Gibson circuit court may appoint one (1) full-time magistrate under IC 33-23-5 to serve both courts.
- (c) The magistrate continues in office until removed by the judge of the Gibson superior court and the judge of the Gibson circuit court.

SECTION 2. IC 33-33-29-6, AS AMENDED BY P.L.12-2014, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 6. (a) The judge of the Hamilton circuit court and the judges of the Hamilton superior courts may jointly appoint three (3) four (4) full-time magistrates under IC 33-23-5 to serve the circuit and superior courts.

(b) A magistrate continues in office until jointly removed by the judge of the Hamilton circuit court and the judges of the Hamilton

Replace the effective date in SECTION 1 with "[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]".

Page 1, line 4, delete "judge" and insert "judges".

Page 1, line 4, after "court" insert "and Gibson circuit court".

Page 1, line 5, delete "the superior court." and insert "both courts.".

Page 1, line 7, delete "court." and insert "court and the judge of the Gibson circuit court.".

Page 1, after line 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 2. IC 33-33-29-6, AS AMENDED BY P.L.12-2014, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 6. (a) The judge of the Hamilton circuit court and the judges of the Hamilton superior courts may jointly appoint three (3) four (4) full-time magistrates under IC 33-23-5 to serve the circuit and superior courts.

(b) A magistrate continues in office until jointly removed by the judge of the Hamilton circuit court and the judges of the Hamilton superior courts.".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
