**Synopsis:** Use of headlights in bad weather. Specifies that unfavorable atmospheric conditions requiring the use of vehicle headlights include rain, snow, and fog.

### **HOUSE BILL No. 1151**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

2	SECTION 363, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 2. (a) Except as provided in
4	subsection (b) and section 8 of this chapter, each vehicle upon a
5	highway:
6	(1) between the time from sunset to sunrise; and
7	(2) at any other time when, due to insufficient light or unfavorable
8	atmospheric conditions, including rainfall, snowfall, and fog,
9	persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible at
10	a distance of five hundred (500) feet ahead;
11	must display lighted head lamps and other illuminating devices as
12	required for different classes of vehicles under this chapter.
13	(b) All lamp equipment required for vehicles described in IC 9-19-6,
14	including each tail lamp required by law, shall be lighted at the times

mentioned in subsection (a), except that clearance and sidemarker

lamps are not required to be lighted on a vehicle when the vehicle is

operated within a municipality if there is sufficient light to render
