## **HOUSE BILL No. 1231**

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 25-23.6-11-4.

**Synopsis:** Ban on conversion therapy. Prohibits a mental health provider from engaging in conversion therapy with a patient less than 18 years of age, and subjects a mental health provider who violates the prohibition to disciplinary action.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1231**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 25-23.6-11-4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 4. (a) As used in this section,
"conversion therapy" means any practice or treatment that seeks
to change an individual's sexual orientation or gender identity,
including any effort to change gender expression or to eliminate or
reduce sexual or romantic attraction or feelings toward individuals
of the same gender. The term does not include counseling intended
to assist a person undergoing gender transition, provide
acceptance, support, and understanding to a person, or facilitate
the individual's coping, social support, or identity exploration and
development as long as the counseling does not seek to change the
individual's sexual orientation or gender identity.

- (b) As used in this section, "mental health provider" includes the following:
  - (1) A psychiatrist or physician who is licensed under IC 25-22.5.



1	(2) A psychologist who is licensed under IC 25-33.
2	(3) An individual who holds a license under this article.
3	(4) A school psychologist licensed by the Indiana state board
4	of education.
5	(5) A registered nurse, an advanced practice registered nurse,
6	or a licensed practical nurse licensed under IC 25-23.
7	(c) A mental health provider may not engage in conversion
8	therapy with a patient less than eighteen (18) years of age.
9	(d) A mental health provider who violates this section is subject
10	to discipline under IC 25-1-9.
