DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Study impact of violent crime on public health. Requires the legislative council to assign to the appropriate interim study committee the study of the impact of violent crime as a public health issue.

Effective: Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning the general assembly.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The legislative**
- 2 **council created by IC 2-5-1.1-1 shall assign to the appropriate**
- 3 **interim study committee established under IC 2-5-1.3 the study of**
- 4 **the impact of violent crime as a public health issue.**
- 5 (b) **This SECTION expires January 1, 2021.**
- 6 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
