## **HOUSE BILL No. 1262**

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-13-2-150.4; IC 9-21-8-48.

Synopsis: Vehicle operation. Provides that a vehicle may not be driven or moved on a highway unless the vehicle is: (1) constructed; (2) covered; or (3) loaded; in a manner that prevents any of the vehicle's refuse or load, other than water, from dripping, sifting, leaking, dropping, blowing, spilling, or otherwise escaping from the vehicle. Requires areas of a vehicle containing aggregate material to be free from holes, cracks, or openings through which any of the vehicle's refuse or load may escape. Specifies that restrictions regarding a vehicle's aggregate material or load apply regardless of the degree to which the vehicle is loaded. Excepts a vehicle containing agricultural commodities from the restrictions concerning a vehicle's refuse or load.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

7	section, "refuse" means solid and semisolid wastes, dead animals,
8	and offal.
9	(b) A vehicle, except:
10	(1) a vehicle containing poultry or livestock; being transported to
11	market; or
12	(2) a vehicle containing agricultural commodities, including
13	corn, soybeans, wheat, or similar commodities; or
14	(2) (3) a highway maintenance vehicle engaged in spreading sand
15	or deicing chemicals;
16	may not be driven or moved on a highway if the vehicle's contents are
17	unless the vehicle is constructed, covered, or loaded in a manner



that prevents any of its refuse or load, other than water, from
dripping, sifting, leaking, dropping, blowing, spilling, or otherwise
escaping from the vehicle.

- (c) Areas of a vehicle containing aggregate material may not have any holes, cracks, or openings through which any of the vehicle's contents or load may escape.
- (d) The restrictions described in subsections (b) and (c) shall apply regardless of the degree to which the vehicle is loaded.
