

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1276

DIGEST OF HB 1276 (Updated February 26, 2024 10:48 am - DI 153)

Citations Affected: IC 13-15.

Synopsis: Notice of a public hearing or meeting. Provides that the commissioner of the department of environmental management (department) may, not later than 10 days after the last day of a public comment period, decide to hold a public hearing or meeting before the issuance or denial of a permit. Requires the department to provide notice if a public hearing or meeting will be held.

Effective: July 1, 2024.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1276

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

| I | SECTION 1. IC 13-15-5-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE |

| 4 | a public comment period under this article or applicable rules of |
| 5 | the board, the commissioner may decide, based on information |
| 6 | received during the public comment period, to hold a public |
| 7 | hearing or meeting before the issuance or denial of a permit. If the |
| 8 | commissioner decides to hold a public hearing or meeting under |
| 9 | this section, the department shall: |
| 0 | (1) immediately notify the applicant of the decision to hold the |
| 1 | public hearing or meeting; and |
| 2 | (2) as soon as practicable, provide notice to the applicant and |
| 3 | any interested persons of the date, time, and location of the |
| 4 | public hearing or meeting. |
