

## **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1334**

DIGEST OF HB 1334 (Updated February 17, 2020 11:23 am - DI 135)

Citations Affected: IC 16-41.

**Synopsis:** Radon mitigation. Provides the state department of health (state department) with emergency rulemaking authority to amend provisions in the state department's administrative rules concerning radon. Requires the state department to amend provisions in the state department's administrative rules concerning radon using the regular rulemaking process before December 31, 2021. Provides that the provisions added by the bill expire July 1, 2022.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

# ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1334

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 16-41-38-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA

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2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 2.5. (a) The state department
4	shall adopt emergency rules in the manner provided under
5	IC 4-22-2-37.1 to amend provisions in 410 IAC 5.1 that concern the
6	following:
7	(1) The certification and standards requirements
8	recommended by the federal Environmental Protection
9	Agency applicable to:
0	(A) radon testing;
1	(B) radon mitigation; and
2	(C) laboratory analysis.
3	(2) Revisions and updates to the administrative rule's
4	definitions and exclusions.
5	(b) Before December 31, 2021, the state department shall adopt
6	rules under IC 4-22-2 to amend provisions in 410 IAC 5.1 that
7	concern the following:

4	(A) radon testing;
5	(B) radon mitigation; and

7	(2) Revisions and updates to the administrative rule's
