HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1334

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 16-41-38-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 2.5. (a) The state department shall adopt emergency rules in the manner provided under IC 4-22-2-37.1 to amend provisions in 410 IAC 5.1 that concern the following:

- (1) The certification and standards requirements recommended by the federal Environmental Protection Agency applicable to:
 - (A) radon testing;
 - (B) radon mitigation; and
 - (C) laboratory analysis.
- (2) Revisions and updates to the administrative rule's definitions and exclusions.
- (b) Before December 31, 2021, the state department shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to amend provisions in 410 IAC 5.1 that concern the following:
 - (1) The certification and standards requirements recommended by the federal Environmental Protection Agency applicable to:
 - (A) radon testing;
 - (B) radon mitigation; and



- (C) laboratory analysis.
- (2) Revisions and updates to the administrative rule's definitions and exclusions.
- (c) This section expires July 1, 2022.
