DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-5-1-14.

Synopsis: COVID-19 relief for businesses. Establishes the business owner compensation fund for the purpose of funding payments to business owners in compensation for business losses experienced before July 1, 2021, that were caused by the state as a result of executive orders issued due to coronavirus disease (COVID-19). Makes an appropriation.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

HOUSE BILL No. 1336

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 4-5-1-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

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2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2021]: Sec. 14. (a) The business owner compensation fund is
4	established for the purpose of providing payments to business
5	owners in compensation for business losses caused by the state as
6	a result of executive orders issued for public health purposes due
7	to coronavirus disease (COVID-19). The fund shall be
8	administered by the secretary of state.
9	(b) The fund consists of:
10	(1) appropriations by the general assembly; and
11	(2) grants, gifts, and donations intended for deposit in the
12	fund.
13	(c) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from
14	money in the fund.
15	(d) The secretary of state shall use money in the fund to make
16	payments to business owners in compensation for business losses
17	caused by the state as a result of executive orders issued for public



1	health purposes due to coronavirus disease (COVID-19).
2	(e) An owner of an Indiana business that experienced business
3	losses before July 1, 2021, that were caused by the state as a result
4	of executive orders issued for public health purposes due to
5	coronavirus disease (COVID-19) may file a request for payment in
6	a form prescribed by the secretary of state. An applicant shall
7	provide all information that the secretary of state finds necessary
8	to make a determination for payment eligibility.
9	(f) Any money remaining in the business owner compensation
10	fund on June 30, 2024, reverts to the state general fund.
11	(g) This section expires July 1, 2024.
12	SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021] (a) There is
13	appropriated to the business owner compensation fund established
14	by IC 4-5-1-14, as added by this act, one hundred million dollars

(\$100,000,000) from the state general fund to be used for the

purposes of the business owner compensation fund.

(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2024.

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
