## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 20-26-18.2-5.

**Synopsis:** School resource officers. Provides that, after June 30, 2020, a law enforcement officer or a school security officer must complete 40 hours of certified school resource officer training before the law enforcement officer or school security officer may be employed by or enter into a contract with a school corporation or charter school to provide school security services during normal school hours.

**Effective:** Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-26-18.2-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 5. After June 30, 2020, a law**  
4 **enforcement officer or a school security officer must complete the**  
5 **training described in section 1(b)(2) of this chapter before the law**  
6 **enforcement officer or school security officer may be employed by**  
7 **or enter into a contract with a school corporation or charter school**  
8 **to provide school security services during normal school hours.**

9 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
