DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-1-8-8.5.

Synopsis: Government fraud hotline. Requires (rather than allows) the executive or fiscal officer of a county, city, town, or township (unit) to establish a hotline telephone number for the public to report suspected fraudulent activity concerning officers and employees of the unit.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

SECTION 1. IC 36-1-8-8.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.181-2015,
SECTION 47, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 8.5. An executive or a fiscal officer of a unit may
shall establish a fraud hotline telephone number maintained by the unit
that the public may use to report suspected fraudulent activity
concerning officers or employees of the unit, including misuse of
public funds.
