

HOUSE BILL No. 1443

DIGEST OF HB 1443 (Updated January 30, 2019 8:58 am - DI 133)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Task force to study schools for the deaf and blind. Establishes the Indiana Schools for the Deaf and the Blind or Visually Impaired task force (task force) to evaluate and make recommendations to the budget committee relating to the operation of the physical plants of the Indiana School for the Deaf and the Indiana School for the Blind or Visually Impaired. Provides that the task force shall make its final recommendations to the budget committee on or before December 1, 2020. Establishes the task force advisory committee (advisory committee) to advise the task force on matters necessary for the task force to carry out its responsibilities. Provides that the department of administration shall provide staffing and administrative support for the task force and the advisory committee.

Effective: Upon passage.

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January 15, 2019, read first time and referred to Committee on Education. January 31, 2019, reported — Do Pass.

HOUSE BILL No. 1443

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The definitions
2	used in IC 20 apply throughout this SECTION.
3	(b) As used in this SECTION, "advisory committee" refers to
4	the task force advisory committee established in subsection (g).
5	(c) As used in this SECTION, "task force" refers to the Indiana
6	Schools for the Deaf and the Blind or Visually Impaired task force
7	established in subsection (d).
8	(d) The Indiana Schools for the Deaf and the Blind or Visually
9	Impaired task force is established to evaluate and make
0	recommendations to the budget committee relating to the
1	operation of the physical plants of the Indiana School for the Deaf
2	and the Indiana School for the Blind or Visually Impaired. The
3	task force consists of the following members:
4	(1) The superintendent of the Indiana School for the Deaf, or
5	the superintendent's designee.
6	(2) The superintendent of the Indiana School for the Blind or
7	Visually Impaired, or the superintendent's designee.
8	(3) The commissioner of the department of administration

2	(4) One (1) member, who is a current or former student of the
3	Indiana School for the Deaf, appointed by the governor.
4	(5) One (1) member, who is a current or former student of the
5	Indiana School for the Blind or Visually Impaired, appointed

7	(6) One (1) member, nominated by Hear Indiana
8	(HearIndiana.org) and appointed by the governor.
9	(7) One (1) member of the senate, appointed by the president

12	by the speaker of the house of representatives.
13	(e) The chairperson of the legislative council during the 2019
14	interim shall appoint one (1) of the members under subsection (d)
15	to serve as chairperson of the task force. The task force shall meet
16	at the call of the chairperson of the task force. Each member
17	appointed under subsection (d) serves at the will of the member's
18	appointing authority. A quorum of the task force consists of five (5)
19	members. The affirmative vote of at least five (5) members is
20	necessary for the task force to approve the final report and for
21	other official action of the task force.
22 23 24	(f) The task force shall do the following:
23	(1) On or before December 1, 2019, make recommendations
24	to the budget committee as to whether the Indiana School for
25	the Deaf and the Indiana School for the Blind or Visually
26	Impaired should be combined into a single campus.

28	schools described in subdivision (1) into a single campus, the
29	task force shall evaluate and make recommendations to the
30	budget committee regarding how to implement master plans

2	(4) Make final recommendations that comply with Article 9
3	Section 1 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana to the
4	budget committee on or before December 1, 2020.
5	(g) The task force advisory committee is established to advise
6	the task force, in a manner prescribed by the task force, on matters
7	necessary for the task force to carry out its responsibilities under
8	this SECTION. The advisory committee is composed of the
9	following members:
10	(1) The operations director for the Indiana School for the
11	Deaf.
12	(2) The operations director for the Indiana School for the
13	Blind or Visually Impaired.
14	(3) The budget director, or the budget director's designee.
15	(4) The commissioner of the commission for higher education,
16	or the commissioner's designee.
17	(5) The superintendent of public instruction, or the
18	superintendent of public instruction's designee.
19	(6) One (1) member representing the construction industry.
20	appointed by the governor.
21	(7) One (1) member who is a parent of a current student at the
22	Indiana School for the Deaf, appointed by the governor.
23	(8) One (1) member who is a parent of a current student at the
24	Indiana School for the Blind or Visually impaired, appointed
25	by the governor.
26	(h) The chairperson of the legislative council during the 2019
27	interim shall appoint one (1) of the members under subsection (g)
28	to serve as chairperson of the advisory committee. The advisory
29	committee shall meet at the call of the chairperson of the task force
30	or the chairperson of the advisory committee. Each member
31	appointed by the governor under subsection (g) serves at the will
32	of the governor. A quorum of the advisory committee consists of
33	five (5) members. The advisory committee shall make
34	recommendations and advise the task force in a manner prescribed
35	by the chairperson of the task force.
36	(i) The department of administration created by IC 4-13-1-2
37	shall provide staffing and administrative support for the task force
38	and the advisory committee necessary for the task force and
39	advisory committee to carry out their duties and responsibilities
40	under this SECTION.

(j) Each member of the task force or advisory committee who is ${\bf r}$

not a state employee or a member of the general assembly is not



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entitled to the minimum salary per diem or reimbursement for traveling expenses and other expenses. Each member of the task force or advisory committee who is a state employee but who is not a member of the general assembly is entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses and other expenses actually incurred in connection with the member's duties, as provided in the state travel policies and procedures established by the department of administration and approved by the budget agency. Each member of the task force who is a member of the general assembly is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid to legislative members of interim study committees established by the legislative council. Per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid under this subsection shall be paid from appropriations made to the legislative council or the legislative services agency.

- (k) Meetings of the task force and the advisory committee must comply with IC 5-14-1.5.
- (l) This SECTION expires January 1, 2021.
- 19 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
