DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.1-11-6.

Synopsis: Transfer of a license plate to another vehicle. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to permit the transfer of a vehicle registration and license plate to another vehicle acquired or owned by a person prior to the vehicle registration's expiration date upon the payment of certain fees.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

HOUSE BILL No. 1676

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 9-18.1-11-6, AS AMENDED BY P.L.256-2017,
SECTION 125, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 6. (a) A person that sells on
otherwise disposes of a wishes to transfer a vehicle's registration to
another vehicle acquired or owned by the person before the date on
which the vehicle's registration expires may apply to the bureau to
transfer the registration and license plates to a another vehicle
acquired or owned by the person.

- (b) This subsection applies if the vehicle to which the registration and license plate are transferred is of the same type and in the same weight class as the vehicle for which the registration and license plate were originally issued. The bureau shall transfer the registration and license plate and issue an amended certificate of registration to the person applying for the transfer after the person pays the following:
 - (1) A fee of nine dollars and fifty cents (\$9.50). The fee shall be distributed as follows:
 - (A) Twenty-five cents (\$0.25) to the state police building
