6	Marion County Sheriff's Office;
7	Whereas, Deputy Durm was killed in the line of duty on
8	Monday, July 10th, 2023, while transporting an inmate to the
9	Indianapolis Community Justice Campus from Eskenazi
10	Hospital;
11	Whereas, He is survived by his significant other, four sons,
12	his parents, and several other treasured family members;
13	Whereas, Deputy Durm is remembered as a devoted father to
14	his four sons, a conscientious peace officer, and a man with a
15	great sense of humor and love for animals; and
16	Whereas, Deputy Durm dedicated his career to serving the
17	people of Marion County and keeping them safe: Therefore,
18	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives
19	of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,
20	the Senate concurring:
