1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing the Indiana
2 State Bar Association Leadership Development Academy.

3 *Whereas, The Indiana State Bar Association Leadership*
4 *Development Academy (LDA) empowers and develops lawyers*
5 *to be informed, committed, and involved in order to serve as*
6 *role models in matters of ethics and professionalism in local*
7 *and state bar associations, Indiana communities, and*
8 *organizations;*

9 *Whereas, The LDA Class of 2020, the ninth annual class of*
10 *the program, consists of 25 Indiana lawyers who have been*
11 *admitted to practice law for 15 years or less;*

12 *Whereas, The LDA incorporates professional facilitators and*
13 *prominent leaders from various disciplines to inform*
14 *participants about leadership principles and techniques, the*
15 *importance of effective leaders in organizations and*
16 *governments for the maximization of efficiency and*
17 *effectiveness, and the challenges and rewards of leadership in*
18 *action;*

19 *Whereas, The LDA class members are selected from around*
20 *the state and are exposed to topics such as public service,*
21 *economic development, government, the military, leadership,*
22 *diversity and inclusion, and other related leadership topics;*

23 *Whereas, As the LDA class members travel around the state,*
24 *they actively engage in panel discussions, group activities, and*
25 *demonstrations with faculty who include Indiana Supreme*
26 *Court Justices, Court of Appeals and trial court judges,*



1 *members of the executive and legislative branches of Indiana*
2 *government, and prominent business and military leaders;*

3 *Whereas, One of the principal themes of the LDA is*
4 *"Leadership begins with the attitude of a servant leader - to*
5 *serve first, and out of service we are given the honor to lead";*
6 *and*

7 *Whereas, February 17, 2020, and February 18, 2020, mark*
8 *the LDA session days when focus is placed on local and state*
9 *government and conflict resolution by providing the class the*
10 *opportunity to get acquainted with members of the Indiana*
11 *Supreme Court, the Indiana Court of Appeals, the federal and*
12 *Bankruptcy Court, the governor, members of the media, and*
13 *representatives of the FBI, and to discuss issues with Indiana*
14 *legislators: Therefore,*

15 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*
16 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
17 *the Senate concurring:*

18 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes
19 the importance of the education provided by the Indiana State
20 Bar Association's Leadership Development Academy.

21 SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of
22 Representatives shall transmit copies of this resolution to the
23 Indiana State Bar Association Leadership Academy and the
24 members of the ninth annual class.
