HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION No. ____

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing the Indiana
State Bar Association Leadership Development Academy.
Whereas, The Indiana State Bar Association Leadership
Development Academy (LDA) empowers and develops lawyers
to be informed, committed, and involved in order to serve as
role models in matters of ethics and professionalism in local
and state bar associations, Indiana communities, and
organizations;
Whereas, The LDA Class of 2020, the ninth annual class of
the program, consists of 25 Indiana lawyers who have been
admitted to practice law for 15 years or less;
Whereas, The LDA incorporates professional facilitators and
prominent leaders from various disciplines to inform
participants about leadership principles and techniques, the
importance of effective leaders in organizations and
governments for the maximization of efficiency and
effectiveness, and the challenges and rewards of leadership in
action;
Whereas, The LDA class members are selected from around
the state and are exposed to topics such as public service,
economic development, government, the military, leadership,
diversity and inclusion, and other related leadership topics;
Whereas, As the LDA class members travel around the state,
they actively engage in panel discussions, group activities, and
demonstrations with faculty who include Indiana Supreme
Court Justices, Court of Appeals and trial court judges,

3	Whereas, One of the principal themes of the LDA is
4	"Leadership begins with the attitude of a servant leader - to
5	serve first, and out of service we are given the honor to lead";

7	Whereas, February 17, 2020, and February 18, 2020, mark
8	the LDA session days when focus is placed on local and state
9	government and conflict resolution by providing the class the
10	opportunity to get acquainted with members of the Indiana
11	Supreme Court, the Indiana Court of Appeals, the federal and
12	Bankruptcy Court, the governor, members of the media, and
13	representatives of the FBI, and to discuss issues with Indiana
14	legislators: Therefore,
15	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives
16	of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,
17	the Senate concurring:
18	SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes
19	the importance of the education provided by the Indiana State
20	Bar Association's Leadership Development Academy.
21	SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of
22	Representatives shall transmit copies of this resolution to the
