

HOUSE RESOLUTION No. ___

A HOUSE RESOLUTION encouraging the Division of Mental Health and Addiction to conduct a review of existing inpatient facilities that provide treatment for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) in the State of Indiana and to provide recommendations to the Indiana General Assembly to increase access to SUD treatments across the state.

Whereas, The Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA) with the Family and Social Services Administration works tirelessly to support all Hoosiers in need of mental health and addiction services in the State of Indiana;

Whereas, The DMHA is responsible for certifying all community mental health centers and addiction treatment service providers in the state;



Whereas, The Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental 1 Disorders is used as an authoritative guide for health care 2 3 professionals to diagnose and discuss mental disorders in patients across the United States of America and around the 4 world and emphasizes the term "Substance Use Disorder" in 5 place of "substance abuse" and other previously used terms; 6 7 Whereas, The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration with the U.S. Department of Health and Human 8 9 Services states that SUD occurs when "the recurrent use of alcohol and/or drugs causes clinically and functionally 10 significant impairment, such as health problems, disability, and 11 failure to meet major responsibilities at work, school, or home" 12 and can be defined as mild, moderate, or severe; 13 Whereas, SUD may refer to substances including but not 14 15 limited to alcohol, tobacco, cannabis, stimulants. hallucinogens, and opioids; 16 Whereas, The House of Representatives recognizes the 17 18 importance of providing accessible SUD treatment to Hoosiers in need across Indiana; 19 20 Whereas, The House of Representatives strongly encourages that the DMHA conduct a review of existing inpatient facilities 21 that provide treatment for SUD in the State of Indiana and to 22 provide any recommendations to the Indiana General Assembly 23 that would increase access to SUD treatments across the state: 24 and 25 Whereas, The House of Representatives requests that any 26 findings or recommendations by the DMHA be submitted before 27 November 1, 2019, to the Indiana General Assembly in an 28 electronic format under IC 5-14-6: Therefore, 29 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the 30 General Assembly of the State of Indiana: 31 SECTION 1. That the House of Representatives strongly 32 encourages the Division of Mental Health and Addiction to 33 conduct a review of existing inpatient facilities that provide 34 treatment for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) in the State of 35

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Indiana and to provide recommendations to the Indiana General 1 Assembly to increase access to SUD treatments across the state. 2 SECTION 2.
