## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 20-26-12-1.

**Synopsis:** Curricular material rental. Provides that a governing body of a school corporation (governing body) may (instead of shall) rent curricular materials to each student enrolled in a public school that is located within the attendance unit served by the governing body. Provides that a governing body may not require a student enrolled in a public school located within the attendance unit served by the governing body to purchase curricular materials.

**Effective:** July 1, 2020.

# SENATE BILL No. 7



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-26-12-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.233-2015,  
2 SECTION 150, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 1. (a) Except as provided in  
4 subsection (b) and notwithstanding any other law, each governing  
5 body:  
6 (1) shall purchase from a publisher, either individually or through  
7 a purchasing cooperative of school corporations, the curricular  
8 materials selected by the proper local officials; and ~~shall~~  
9 (2) **may** rent the curricular materials to each student enrolled in  
10 a public school that is:  
11 (†) (A) in compliance with the minimum certification  
12 standards of the state board; and  
13 (‡) (B) located within the attendance unit served by the  
14 governing body.  
15 (b) This section does not prohibit a governing body from suspending  
16 the operation of this section under a contract entered into under  
17 IC 20-26-15.



1           **(c) A governing body may not require a student enrolled in a**  
2           **public school described in subsection (a)(2) to purchase curricular**  
3           **materials.**
