DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-26-12-1.

Synopsis: Curricular material rental. Provides that a governing body of a school corporation (governing body) may (instead of shall) rent curricular materials to each student enrolled in a public school that is located within the attendance unit served by the governing body. Provides that a governing body may not require a student enrolled in a public school located within the attendance unit served by the governing body to purchase curricular materials.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

5	(b) This section does not prohibit a governing body from suspending
