## SENATE BILL No. 14

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:* 

SECTION 1. IC 33-33-45-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 10. (a) The judges of
the criminal division may appoint two (2) full-time magistrates under
IC 33-23-5 to serve the criminal division. A magistrate appointed under
this subsection continues in office until removed by the judges of the
criminal division.

- (b) The judge of criminal division No. 4 may appoint one (1) full-time magistrate under IC 33-23-5 to serve criminal division No. 4. A magistrate appointed under this subsection continues in office until removed by the judge of criminal division No. 4.
- (b) (c) The judges of the civil division may appoint two (2) full-time magistrates under IC 33-23-5 to serve the civil division. A magistrate appointed under this subsection continues in office until removed by the judges of the civil division.
