A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-33-45-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 10. (a) The judges of  
3 the criminal division may appoint two (2) full-time magistrates under  
4 IC 33-23-5 to serve the criminal division. A magistrate appointed under  
5 this subsection continues in office until removed by the judges of the  
6 criminal division.

7 **(b) The judge of criminal division No. 4 may appoint one (1)**  
8 **full-time magistrate under IC 33-23-5 to serve criminal division**  
9 **No. 4. A magistrate appointed under this subsection continues in**  
10 **office until removed by the judge of criminal division No. 4.**

11 ~~(b)~~ (c) The judges of the civil division may appoint two (2) full-time  
12 magistrates under IC 33-23-5 to serve the civil division. A magistrate  
13 appointed under this subsection continues in office until removed by  
14 the judges of the civil division.
