### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-28-3-9.5.

**Synopsis:** Seizure training requirements. Provides that school corporations and charter schools shall require all applicants for employment and school employees who will have direct, ongoing contact with children within the scope of the applicant's or school employee's employment to attend training concerning recognition of the signs and symptoms of seizures and the appropriate steps to be taken to respond to these symptoms.

Effective: July 1, 2024.

### SENATE BILL No. 56

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:* 

SECTION 1. IC 20-28-3-9.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

AS A <b>NEW</b> SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
1, 2024]: Sec. 9.5. (a) Each school corporation and charter school
shall require all applicants for employment who will have direct,
ongoing contact with children within the scope of the applicant's
employment to attend, before or not later than thirty (30) days
after the start date of the applicant's employment, training
concerning recognition of the signs and symptoms of seizures and
the appropriate steps to be taken to respond to these symptoms.
(b) Each school corporation and charter school shall require all
school employees who have direct, ongoing contact with children
within the scope of the employee's employment to attend the
training described in subsection (a) annually.
(c) The format of the training required under this section may
