

SENATE BILL No. 78

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-28-28.4-2.

Synopsis: Shovel ready site development center. Defines "office" as the office of community and rural affairs for purposes of the law governing the shovel ready site development center (center). Provides that the office shall, in cooperation with the Indiana economic development corporation and political subdivisions, administer the center to enable political subdivisions to obtain permits to create sites that are ready for economic development. Provides that the office shall serve as the certifying body for acceptance into the program and determine the criteria to be used to certify sites.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

8 **regulation, ordinance, or resolution.**
9 **(b) In addition to the duties set forth in section 1 of this chapter, the**
10 **shovel ready site development center shall, in cooperation with**
11 **political subdivisions, create programs to enable political subdivisions**
12 **to obtain all or part of any permits to create sites that are ready for**
13 **economic development.**
14 **(c) To support the duties set forth in section 1 of this chapter,**
15 **the office shall, in cooperation with the corporation and political**
16 **subdivisions, administer the shovel ready site development center**
17 **to enable political subdivisions to obtain all or part of any permits**
