DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 2-2.1.

Synopsis: Session adjournment deadlines. Changes the latest day for the general assembly to adjourn sine die in the first regular session from April 29 to March 31 beginning with the 2021 session. Changes the latest day for the general assembly to adjourn sine die in the second regular session from March 14 to February 14 beginning with the 2022 session. Makes conforming changes.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

27	(2) a date earlier than April 29 March 31 in odd-numbered years
28	beginning after December 31, 2020, and March February 14 in
29	even-numbered years beginning after December 31, 2021, if the
30	presiding officers of each body have:
31	(A) jointly agreed; and
32	(B) publicly announced;
33	that the earlier date will be the final day of session.
